Example:

There was once a company that had to create quarterly reports on several sets of data. They were used to using Excel to create the tables and it was working well. Then I started there and decided to implement a database to track the project. Within 2 Quarters it took less than half the time to generate the same tables, and they could easily create several others without any additional work. They could also export the data in a format that was easily read by other software programs, making figure preparation faster and more reliable since numbers did not have to be reentered.
